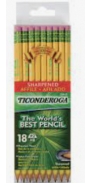


Beginnergarten & Kindergarten Supply list

- ☐ 1 pkg. Expo Fine-Tip dry erase markers
(BLACK)

(underwear, socks, pants/shorts, shirt)

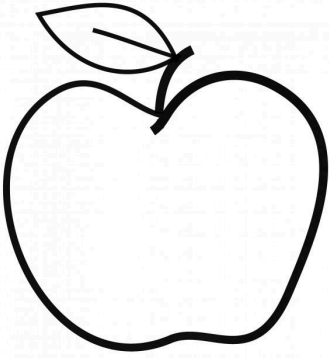


- ☐ 1 large backpack (No wheels and label it with child's name)

You may be wondering what you can do now to help prepare your student for school?

Below is a list of basic skills to work on.

Language skills:

- ☐ Speak in complete sentences
- ☐ Follow 2 step directions
- ☐ Ask for help when needed

Social Emotional Skills:

- ☐ Take turns and share
- ☐ Try to solve problems on their own
- ☐ Interact with others
- ☐ Follow simple directions
- ☐ Express and identify their feelings

Self Care Skills:

- ☐ Go to the restroom independently
- ☐ Button and unbutton their own clothes
- ☐ Clean up after themselves
- ☐ Wash their hands

Fine Motor Skills:

- ☐ Write first name
- ☐ Use pencil, scissors and glue sticks
- ☐ Color within the lines

Literacy Skills:

- ☐ Sit and listen to a story
- ☐ Recognize name in print
- ☐ Say the alphabet

Math Skills:

- ☐ Count aloud to 10 or beyond
- ☐ Count objects 1 to 1
- ☐ Recognize basic shapes and colors
